

## XAVIER FEE SCHEDULE 2020-21

Valid from 30 September 2020

At Xavier, we provide a range of multi-disciplinary services to support children and young people with high needs to live the best lives possible with their family. From occupational therapy, physiotherapy, speech therapy and equipment hire through to support workers, nursing, short term accommodation and NDIS support, we're here to help.

Our team of therapists provide assessment, advice and support around your child's development and therapy needs. Our therapists are also specialised in providing advice and applications for children and adults for equipment (Assistive Technology), and home and vehicles modifications.

Our Direct Support Staff are highly trained and provide professional and high quality support to children and young people with disabilities. This includes services for children/young people with complex, multiple disabilities and medical fragility. Our staff are trained by Registered Nurses and Occupational Therapists and receive extensive training in a wide range of areas.

### Support Services

Types of support include:

- Personal Care & Daily activities
- In Home Support
- Recreational activities in the community, in a group or in a centre
- Assistance with the integration with school or other mainstream services

**ESTABLISHMENT FEE** - includes an initial meeting with your Coordinator to document the participant's support needs, shift preferences and staff requirements, and development and implementation of a Support plan

Where you are a new client and you will receive at least 20 hours of personal care and/or community access support per month

#### **DAILY ACTIVITIES/COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION - STANDARD INTENSITY SUPPORTS**

A support is considered a standard intensity support if the participant only requires assistance from a support worker with general training and experience, and a low to medium medical needs support is required.

#### **TRANSPORT & TRAVEL**

Xavier has a limited number of accessible vehicles that are available for transporting participants to and from community access activities. It is our intention to continue supporting participants ability to access to the community so our prices are set to only recover the running cost of vehicle.

**DAILY ACITIVITIES/COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION - HIGH INTENSITY SUPPORTS**

A support is considered a high intensity support if the participant requires assistance from a support worker with additional qualifications and experience relevant to the participant's complex needs. The high Intensity medical support needs include, but not limited to the following:

- Complex Bowel care
- Enteral Feeding and Management
- Tracheostomy Care
- Urinary Catheters
- Complex Epilepsy
- Ventilation
- Subcutaneous injection
- Manage diabetes
- Administration of high risk medication
- Complex hoist transfers

In addition to the required qualifications and advanced therapy and medical training, the delegated support workers are required to receive additional training specific to the participant's complex needs by our Health Practitioners and Allied Health Professionals. All supports will be supervised and monitored by our Health Practitioners.

**SHADOW SHIFT**

Shadow shifts may be considered where the participant has complex individual support needs that are best met by introducing a new worker to the participant before it is reasonable that they commence providing the support independently.

### Nursing and Health Liaison

• Xavier Registered Nurses have experience in working with families who have children and young people with complex needs. This team can provide supports and training in a variety of health care needs. This service includes health assessment, review/coordinate health care needs, community nursing care, continence aid assessment, support to attend specialist appointments, Nurse Hotline service and more.

• Minimum fee is for 30 minutes with increments of 15 minutes

## Therapy services

- This service includes physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech pathology, equipment (Assistive Technology) prescription, vehicle and home modification (basic & complex), hydrotherapy (where available), music therapy and counselling, including Capacity Building Supports For Early Childhood Interventions. This team can meet with you in your home, early learning centre, school or at our clinics.
- Minimum appointment time is 45 minutes with increments of 15 minutes (appointment times include 10 minutes for documentation)

### Goods and Services Tax (GST)

- GST, where applicable, is additional to the fees detailed above.
- All Xavier supplies are covered under subsection 33 (2) of the National Disability Insurance Scheme Act 2013, and are GST-free to a NDIS participant if all the following requirements are met:
  1. The NDIS participant has NDIS plan in effect
  2. the supply is of reasonable and necessary supports that are specified in the statement of supports in the participant's NDIS plan
  3. The NDIS participant/participant nominee agrees to Xavier General Terms and Conditions

### Other charges

From time to time, Xavier might incur costs, in addition to the cost of a worker's time, when accompanying and/or transporting participants in the community (such as cost of ticket for public transport, entry fee, road tolls, parking fees and etc.), we will seek permission to incur these costs before we proceed and will invoice you for reimbursement if appropriate.

### Cancellations

If a shift or an appointment needs to be cancelled, or there needs to be a change to support times or a scheduled appointment, participants are to advise Xavier by no later than

- Two (2) clear business days' notice for support that is less than 8 hours continuous duration, and the agreed total price for the support is less than \$1000, or
- Five (5) clear business days' notice for any other support

There will not be a charge if Xavier cancels the supports. There may be a charge up to 90% of the price for cancelled appointment if you cancel support shifts or Allied Health appointments if you fail to give notice as outlined above.

### Payment Terms

14 days from the invoice date

### Price Increases

Xavier Fee Schedule will be reviewed annually, and Xavier will include Temporary Transformation Payment (TTP) in its pricing for attendant care and community participation supports.
